## Guidelines for HSI Centre of Excellence

Hernia Society of India invites applications from centres which are a) doing high-volume work in the field of hernia surgery and b) already undertaking regular training courses in hernia surgery to apply to become an HSI Centre of Excellence. This endorsement is purely for the purposes of conducting training courses and is not to be taken as an endorsement for the standard of clinical care provided at the Centre in the field of hernia or other surgeries. Prerequisites In order to be considered an HSI Centre of Excellence the Hospital / Institution must fulfil the following criteria.

- The Centre applying for this (Medical College / Hospital / Nursing home) should have minimum 50 beds. The Courses must be directed by a Surgeon who holds MS or DNB in General surgery and is a member of HSI.
- The Centre must offer both open and laparoscopic surgery for a variety of hernias and the results must be carefully audited and preferably published in peer reviewed journals.
- Two or more training courses must have been held in the Centre each year for the past three years and at least one of them should have been in the field of hernia surgery.
- The Centre must have adequate infrastructure in terms of theatres, laparoscopic equipment, HD endocamera, energy sources etc. They should follow autoclaving, ETD or plasma sterilization for all the laparoscopic equipment used for hernia surgery.
- The Centre must be equipped with adequate facilities for lectures and must have a dry laboratory with endotrainers for hands on practice. Virtual reality simulators are optional.
- The Course Director and Faculty must have appropriate clinical expertise to educate the participants. If live surgery is to be performed and transmitted for the participants, the Faculty must have adequate experience in these procedures.
- The Course Curriculum must include (but need not be restricted to) the following: Patient selection, preoperative care, instrumentation, technical aspects of surgery, postoperative care, identification and management of complications, follow up and tracking of clinical outcomes.
- The HSI endorsement is valid only for three years and can be renewed at the end of that period by way of a fresh application. This endorsement is only for courses conducted in the field of Hernia and Abdominal Wall Surgery.
- The Institution organising the courses must apply for and grant the participants CME points from the State Medical Council.
- Course details, list of Faculty and participant feedback forms for each course must be submitted to the President and Hon. Secretary of HSI (by way of email) on an annual basis. If the review of these shows the courses to be below par and the deficiencies suggested are not corrected within stipulated time, the recognition of the Centre may be withdrawn
- No application fee is required at present, but in future an yearly fee as decided by the Executive Committee of the HSI may be levied on the Centres.

#### **Benefits to the Centre**

- The Centre will be listed as a Centre of Excellence on the HSI website
- The courses offered at the Centre will be listed on the HSI website
- The Course Director may include the HSI endorsement on the course brochure or on the course material.
- The Centres and the courses will be promoted during the annual HSI meeting.

Application Process A formal letter of application along with the following details and photographs (JPEGs) to corroborate the available facilities should be emailed to President - HSI Dr Ramesh Agarwalla (lap.ramesh@gmail.com) and Hon. Secretary-HSI Manish Baijal (mbaijal@yahoo.com). The HSI may designate an observer to visit the centre for inspection before awarding the HSI Centre of Excellence certificate. The travel expenses and local hospitality of the observer should be borne by the Centre.

## Social Media Initiative of Hernia Society of India

The last few years have seen a virtual explosion in the social media. There is a completely new and paradigm shift in the way we share information and interact. This has been further accentuated in the last two years due to Covid pandemic, where conducting physical meetings became a challenge.

HSI has innovated and involved all by embracing the social media. Now our reach is far & wide – even outside the borders of our country. Some of the highlights of HSI social media initiatives are

- 1. HSI Facebook Page The HSI Facebook page (https://www.facebook.com/groups/herniasocietyofindia) was created on September 16. 2018 with Dr Deepraj Bhandarkar, Dr Sumeet Shah, Dr Sarfaraz Baig and Dr Pallawi Priya as its administrators. We encourage Surgeons to share videos, lectures, clinical case discussions, articles and information about events. The HSI Facebook page is also a platform to live broadcast many of the scientific events that we are now conducting like "Whats in the Case" and "Insight into Innovation" series.
  - We now have a total of 3330 members (Surgeons) on HSI Facebook page. In last two months itself we received 678 membership requests out of which 632 were approved after screening. Between, Nov 29, 2021 Jan 28, 2022, HSI Facebook Page logged in 2957 Active Members, a 22 % growth. There were 78 posts, 230 comments & 1153 reactions. The top countries where the members belong to, apart from India include Bangladesh, Pakistan, Nepal, UK, Egypt, Saudi Arabia & UAE. HSI Facebook Page has now become a very resourceful medium of communication and interaction.
- 2. **HSI Twitter Handle** Twitter has become a huge medium not only for information exchange but also for all scientific organisations to have a presence. HSI first created the Twitter handle @Hernialndia in 2018 before the Kolkata annual







conference. It started with some announcements of annual conference. However, in between for 2 yrs. the handle was not actively operated. Now the HSI is active on Twitter and regularly posts all information about HSI activities. We regularly interact with other Societies like the European & American Hernia Society. HSI handle follows some of its active members, related international scientific associations, journals etc. Its followership is growing and currently there are 120 followers of @HerniaIndia. The Twitter handle will help HSI to interact on a global platform and make its activities popular & known to a wide section of surgeons across the world. The Twitter handle is currently being managed by Dr Sumeet Shah.

- 3. **HSI What'sApp Group** It is an easy and simple platform for discussion and sharing cases, information, problem solving etc. The HSI What'sApp page by the name "What's in the Case HSI" was created by Dr Sarfaraz Baig on 16th November 2021. Within days the group admins were flooded with "requests to join" and it filled up the 256 slots available. The group is vibrant with Surgeon's sharing interesting edited videos of hernia cases, asking for solutions & opinions, sharing information on events etc.
- 4. **HSI YouTube Channel** The YouTube channel of Hernia Society of India (www.youtube.com/herniasocietyofindia). has 100 videos now. Lectures on various aspects of Hernia surgery are categorised in multiple playlists. The channel is free to subscribe and a humongous resource for anyone who would like to gain knowledge. All activities done in last two years are now recorded and available on our YouTube channel. There are nearly 5 new videos which get uploaded on YouTube channel every week. Today the HSI YouTube channel has more than 500 subscribers. Dr Vishal Soni, Dr Ashwin Thangavelu and Dr Pallawi Priya have been managing the HSI YouTube channel.
- 5. Website All HSI related information and activities are neatly categorised in our website www.herniasocietyofindia.org. The website has new features including a page which carries a compilation of hernia related, free full text guidelines, systematic reviews, meta-analyses etc. from the past 10 years. Another interesting new section on website has a compilation of some 160 articles related to open and minimally invasive hernia surgery authored by Indian Surgeons over the last 25 years.
